Eligibility Guidelines – All household members must be 62 or older. Applicants eligible for the MRVP subsidized units must have income at or below 30% of the median income. Applicants eligible for LIHTC units must verify rent affordability, these are rent restricted units and therefore there are no subsidies with these units. There is a fulltime student restriction.

Rents – Rents for MRVP apartments are based on 30% - 40% of the monthly income of the household. Rents for LIHTC apartments are tiered by affordability based on household income. Rent for 1 bedroom \$763 or \$876, rent for 2 bedroom \$874 or \$1,052. Utilities are included and cable is offered at a reduced rate. Appliances include stove and refrigerator.

Building and Apartment Features – There is on-site maintenance manager and maintenance service. There is a community room for tenants to use. A coin operated laundry room and an outdoor sitting area. Each apartment contains an emergency pull cord system.

Pets - Pets are allowed in accordance with our Pet Policy.

Resident Services Department – A Resident Service Coordinator is on staff at Berkshire Housing to assist residents with assessment for services and provide coordination of these services.

Waiting List Selection - Waiting list selection will be done on a first come first serve basis in accordance with date and time of application. Apartments are rented without regard to race, religious creed, sex, national origin, gender identity, sexual orientation, genetic information, ancestry, military status, family status, receipt of public assistance, or disability. Federal law prohibits the discrimination against individuals with handicaps. Berkshire Housing Services Inc. will make reasonable accommodations to rules, policies, practices, or services when such accommodations are deemed necessary to afford a person with a disability the equal opportunity to use and enjoy a dwelling.
