**Eligibility Guidelines** - Applicants must be at least 62 years of age or in need of a handicapped accessible unit and must fall within the income limits as listed below. Residents are limited to part-time student status under the requirements of the low income housing tax credit program.

**Income Limits** (maximum annual income allowable, effective (4/18/2022))

One Person \$33,850; for LIHTC units ONLY income limit is \$40,620\*

Two People \$38,650; for LIHTC units ONLY income limit is \$46,380\*

**Rents** - Rents are based on 30% of monthly income with allowances for ongoing medical expenses. Heat, hot water, electric and appliances are included in the rent. Cable is offered at a reduced rate. Applicants eligible for LIHTC units must verify rent affordability, these are rent restricted units and therefore there are no subsidies with these units.

**Building and Apartment Features** - There is an on-site resident site superintendent and maintenance service. There is a furnished community room with a kitchen for the tenants use. There is an elevator and coin operated laundry room. Each apartment has Link to Life.

**This is a non-smoking building.**

**Pets** - Pets are allowed in accordance with Berkshire Housing's pet policy.

**Resident Services Department** - A Resident Service Coordinator is on staff at Berkshire Housing to assist residents with assessment for services and provide coordination of these services.

**Waiting List Selection** – Waiting list selection will be done on a first come first serve basis in accordance with date and time of application. Apartments are rented without regard to race, religious creed, sex, national origin, gender identity, sexual orientation, genetic information, ancestry, military status, family status, receipt of public assistance, or disability. Federal law prohibits the discrimination against individuals with handicaps. Berkshire Housing Services Inc. will make reasonable accommodations to rules, policies, practices, or services when such accommodations are deemed necessary to afford a person with a disability the equal opportunity to use and enjoy a dwelling.
